A NOTE FROM PETE LUTZ



The Narada Radio Company was first created in 2001, the year I wrote my first audio dramas for live performance at Harbor Playhouse. Since we were creating a mock radio broadcast (in the same way "It's a Wonderful Life" is being presented tonight). I wanted a name for the troupe that would evoke the right nostalgic feeling — one like Orson Welles's Mercury Theatre On the Air in the 1930s. Welles, by the way, has been a great inspiration to me - writer, actor, director, producer and

man of great girth. I could think of no better tribute than to give my troupe a name parallel to that of his. Since Mercury was the Messenger of the Gods in Roman Mythology, I went looking for one in a different pantheon. None of them seemed fitting until I found Narada — Hindu Messenger of Vishnu, also famous for storytelling and the ability to see into the future. How perfect! And so the Narada Radio Company was born.

When I took up audio dramas again in 2013 for podcasting purposes. I brought the Narada troupe back into existence. What began with our first episode in October of that year, with a mere 11 players, has grown in the

ensuing nine years into an ensemble of more than 100 actors, with more than 100 audio dramas produced for podcast - including several incarnations of "It's a Wonderful Life," performed at the Rialto in 2018 and 2019, and at the PACT in 2021 and this year. As you may well know, this play was first a film released 76 years ago. It was adapted for Radio radio that same year by the Lux Radio Theatre. The script was in existence, so I tweaked it a little for that first performance. In subsequent years I added in more dialogue and characters from the film to make it a better, more-rounded experience for our audience. This year, we have added an entirely new scene — one that was written for the screenplay, but didn't make it into the finished film. You'll hear it tonight, close to the end and that's the only hint you'll get! If you don't catch it, ask a cast member after the show.

Thanks for coming out for the show. I hope you enjoy it!



A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

"It's a Wonderful Life" is the classic tale of George Bailey and the people of Bedford Falls. This production is an adaptation of the 1947 Lux Radio Theatre Broadcast. To quote *Time Magazine*, "With its range of emotions and its messages of hope, charity, and love, 'It's a Wonderful Life' remains the gold standard, 75 years after its debut."

We are creating what we call "theatre of the mind." It's not your normal stage show. Think of it more like a radio show of old — with a cast of ten taking on the challenge of more than 50 roles, using only their voices — accompanied by



live music and a mix of recorded and live sound effects, all created before your very eyes. This show creates a whole new feel, and we hope, a new appreciation for audio dramas.

Having been a part of the cast for the past four years, I am excited to take on the role of director, bringing the show to the Port Aransas Community Theatre for a second year. There are large shoes to fill, as Pete Lutz did the groundwork for this show — putting together the script, sound effects and so much more. I am also excited at the amount of raw talent each cast member possesses. This is a whole new world to some of them, and they are truly the greatest cast I could have wished for!

"It's a Wonderful Life" is a true classic that has been a traditional staple of my family's holiday celebration. And I am so very honored to help make it a tradition for the Coastal Bend.




